### From the President

KSHA members, we need your support! The Jr's are putting on a fundraising show and to support the show all you have to do is just show up and show your horse or buy some food from the concession stand! So far, we have spent less than \$25 on this show. Everything else has been covered by donations! This includes the venue, the judge, and the announcer. We need to make sure we show our appreciation for these Jr Heros! So, if you show your horse, every \$1 you spend will go towards supporting the Jr's and the Scholarship Fund because of these volunteers!

Every show that is hosted by KSHA is to help support either the banquet (April and September shows) or the Jr's (July show). When you show at the April and September shows, your funds go toward supporting the show itself and whatever is left over goes towards the banquet. Unfortunately, the first show that we had did not get much support and made no profit. If it hadn't been for the grant, we were able to get from Rice County we would have lost around \$1000 on the show. As it is we came very close to breaking even, which means no money was earned to support the year end banquet and prizes.

With no profit from the April show the September show is really going to need your support now. So, to help incentivize our members to attend our show, the board has approved that both the Jr show and the September show be double points! Yes, if you win a class, instead of getting 6 points you will get 12 points! It does not count as attending an extra show so you will still need to attend 3 shows to be eligible for year end awards but that goes a long way toward getting some possible year end awards!

We know times are tough and as a club we are doing everything we can to make coming to the show's fun, easy and economical. We are always looking for new, inexpensive venues that might excite our members and attract new members. Cutting expenses everywhere we can is almost our mantra. Trying to find ways to get the most bang for our buck when it comes to year end awards. And all of this is done by volunteers. Please show our volunteers that all their effort is not for naught. Support our shows in any way you can.

Close! Yes Jeans. Yes, t-shirt that covers shoulders and upper arm. Must have appropriate footwear!













- 1. Start at cone.
- 2. Trot over logs and into box
- 3. Perform a 360 either direction in the box.
- 4. Walk out of box and to barrels.
- 5. Pick up bucket and do figure 8 around barrels then set down bucket.
- 6. step front feet into box. Perform side pass to the right  $\frac{1}{4}$  way around the box.
- 7. walk through box.
- 8. canter right lead into shoot (walk-trot and in-hand will walk, size of loop appropriate to speed and animal)
- 9. back out of shoot
- turn to right and canter half circle to and through box (walk-trot and in-hand will trot, size of loop appropriate to speed and animal)
- 11. drop to a walk and exit the arena.
