Explanation of fun classes! All will be walk/trot friendly

16 Showmanship Swap: You will get a horse at the gate! Let's see your skills with a horse you have never shown! Don't forget to bring your showmanship horse with you as someone else will be showing your horse! Judged exactly like a showmanship class. If you are a beginner showmanship exhibitor, this will not affect your status! (management will approve horses) Judged like a regular showmanship class. No horse, talk to the office! Extra horses available.

21 & 48 Simon Says: This will be similar to disciplined rail just a lot more fun!! If the judge does ask for a canter/lope then the walk/trot participants will just do an extended trot unless they feel comfortable in the canter/lope. (let them know at the start of the class) This will not affect your beginner status! If you miss a command you are out. Last person on the rail wins! The Walk/Whoa - Leadline Simon Says is for the kids in those classes only.

29 Musical Statue: Horse and rider will follow whatever instruction they are given for when the music starts (walk on rail, trot on rail, walk a serpentine along rail, etc) and continues that action until the music stops. When the music stops the horse and rider freezes and whoever is moving the most is eliminated.

55 Steady Eddy: You will be provided a cup with water. At the end of the class, whoever has the most water in the cup wins. You can not hold the cup by the top, only by the side or bottom. This class will Walk and Trot. If the judge asks for a lope and you are not comfortable loping then do an extended trot.

Remember, this show is to support our Junior members and our scholarship fund. We have many people that we already need to thank. Our judge, announcer, and office manager are all supporting our show by donating their time. The arena is a free will donation that we will honor with part of our profits and arena donations. Everyone helping out at the arena and concession are all volunteers. We want to thank everyone for your help in making this a fun show and helping our Jr's get some funds in their account.
